# ST. JOSEPH'S HOSPITAL

## Driving Directions

### From the North

- Take I-35E to the Wacouta/10th Street exit.
- Follow the 10th Street signs and continue on 10th Street approximately six blocks.
- The parking ramp will be on your right approximately one-half block past St. Peter Street.

### From the West

- Take I-94 east to the 10th Street exit.
- Follow 10th Street approximately one-third mile.
- The parking ramp will be on your left.

### From the South

- Take I-35E north to the 11th Street exit.
- Turn right onto St. Peter Street.
- Go approximately one block and turn right onto 10th Street.
- The parking ramp will be on your right approximately one-half block past St. Peter Street.

### From the East

- Take I-94 west to the 12th Street exit.
- Continue on 12th Street to Cedar Street.
- Turn left on Cedar Street two blocks to 10th Street.
- Turn right on 10th Street and continue two blocks.
- The parking ramp will be on your right approximately one-half block past St. Peter Street.

## Parking

**Valet parking** is available at the main entrance at 45 West 10th Street Monday through Friday from 6:30 am to 5 pm. Simply drive to the hospital's main entrance and check your vehicle with the valet on duty.

Patients and visitors are also welcome to park in the **St. Joseph's ramp**. Our parking ramps are fully automated 24/7; no attendants are on duty. Guests can pay with credit cards or with cash, and exact change is not required.

If you prefer, there is some on-street parking near the hospital. Parking meters are enforced.
